# AP or CE?

## AP- Advanced Placement

- ▶ Nationally recognized
- ▶ Credit may be accepted by colleges
- ▶ Check with colleges of interest to determine score and credits accepted
- ▶ Most classes are full year
- ▶ Take test(s) in May

## CE Concurrent Enrollment

- ▶ Accepted by state colleges – May be elective credit
- ▶ Classes are half or full year
- ▶ Credit is based on grade received – Must be C or better
- ▶ Grades appear on college transcript
- ▶ Typically receive 3 college credits per class
