



# AP or CE?

#### <u> AP- Advanced Placement</u>

- Nationally recognized
- Credit may be accepted by colleges
- Check with colleges of interest to determine score and credits accepted
- Most classes are full year
- Take test(s) in May

#### **CE Concurrent Enrollment**

- Accepted by state colleges –May be elective credit
- Classes are half or full year
- Credit is based on gradereceived Must be C or better
- Grades appear on college transcript
- Typically receive 3 college credits per class


