Agenda Items Discussed:

- 1. Jack Hattaway motioned to approve January 11, 2023, minutes; Suzette Jackson seconded the motion. The minutes for January were approved.
- 2. Student Data: Deanne Kapetanov discussed the school report card and explained how grades are figured. Achievement shows typical progress, Growth and Postsecondary Readiness show exemplary. English Learner Progress shows critical needs. ELL students take WIDA. We are working on increasing the buy-in from students for this test so that what they know will reflect in their test scores. We will be administering the ASPIRE+ test in the next couple of months.
- 3. Possible goals/expenditures for 2024: Goal 1 Graduation Rates-increase the graduation rate by .5% among our diverse populations who number more than 10. Goal 2 College and Career Readiness-increase the number of students enrolled in advanced course work (Honors courses, Advance Placement, Concurrent Enrollment) and Career and Technical Education (CTE) by 2% total. We also plan for 25 students to create a plan with the Weber State University counselors to earn the Certificate of Completion. Goal 3 Performing Arts-Maintain student participation rates in performing arts classes while providing full instrumentation and individual instruction and feedback using accompaniment software.
- 4. Principal Report: Teen Wellness Center Ribbon Cutting is February 7, 3:00 pm
- 5. Comprehensive Guidance Report: Course requests for Juniors. ACT coming up. Meeting with feeder schools all are having attendance issues. We gave the ASAB test this month.
- 6. PTSA President Report: Emergency buckets are done, just need to be distributed to teachers.
- 7. Student Body President Report: Fresh start week in January. Planning Sweethearts dance and attending all events. Shrek the Musical this month. Taiwanese students are here and our WXHS students are being their buddies.
