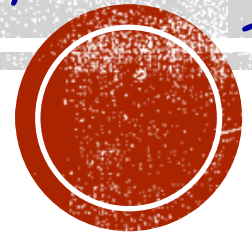

EARN COLLEGE CREDIT IN HIGH SCHOOL

Advanced Placement (AP)

- **Why take AP?**
 1. You can earn college credit nationwide if you pass the end-of-year exam (passing scores vary by university).
 2. You get a challenging, rigorous academic experience.
 3. It prepares you for the rigor of college work.
 4. It looks good on your transcript!

Concurrent Enrollment (CE)

- **Why take CE?**
 1. Earn college credit for earning a C or better
 2. Save money! CE classes are \$5 per credit. After high school, you will pay \$250+ per credit
 3. You get a challenging and rigorous college-level experience





CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

- **Weber State University Certificate of Completion in General Education** is official documentation from the university that a student has completed the general education requirements of an associate or bachelor degree
- **Certain Advanced Placement (AP) & Concurrent Enrollment (CE) courses** apply to the Certificate of Completion
- **37 required credits with 2.0 minimum GPA**

12TH GRADE LANGUAGE ARTS

You MUST take a full year of language arts as a senior

Full-Year Options	Semester Options
AP Language & Literature	CE English 1010: Must earn 18+ on Reading/English sections of same ACT
English 12 (can be taken for one semester + different semester LA class)	CE English 2015: Must earn 29+ on Reading/English sections of same ACT <u>or</u> pass CE 1010 English with C or better
