

## STEPS FOR COLLEGE

1. <u>Apply to post-secondary institutions</u> (university, community college, trade school): You will need to create an account at each college you apply to. <a href="https://wxhs.davis.k12.ut.us/parents-students/counseling-center/applying-to-college">https://wxhs.davis.k12.ut.us/parents-students/counseling-center/applying-to-college</a>

\*Some colleges waive admission fees during UCAW (see link above)\*

\*CE students can simply switch their status to matriculated student\*

- 2. Fill out Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA):

\*Types of scholarships: Merit, talent, departmental, athletic, private\*

- 4. Create your portfolio: Do you need letters of recommendation?
- 5. <u>Follow up</u>: Defer admission and scholarships if you are going into military or missionary service
